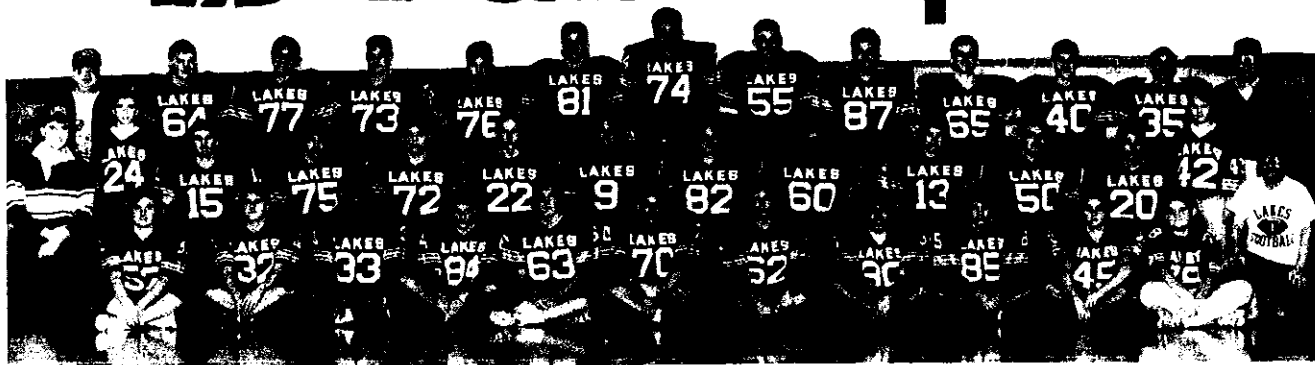

FINAL GAME NOTES — Making its third trip to the finals in four years, Lake Linden-Hubbell returned to the western end of the Upper Peninsula with the Class DD crown. Neither team could muster must offense in the first half, with the exception of Sand Creek's 62-yard drive which produced its lone points of the game. In the second half, the Aggies only got their hands on the ball twice and had nine plays. The Lakes possessed the ball for over 15 minutes in the second half, nearly 11 being a ball-hogging 80-yard drive for its second touchdown.
