**FINAL GAME NOTES** — This was a meeting of first-time finalists in which a bevy of final game records were set. Hartford's Sweat set an all-class record for touchdowns scored and tied the mark for points. Hartford also tied a mark with 23 first downs. Onsted's Dave Hutchinson grabbed 9 passes to set an all-class record; and John Hutchinson's 29 pass attempts and 18 completions were all-class marks for an individual and a team. One of the other game's rare features was that no punts were attempted. Aside from the two Onsted interceptions, every drive either ended in a score, on downs or at the end of a half.
