FINAL GAME NOTES — East Grand Rapids captured its second Class BB title in three years. The Pioneers scored late in the first half on Lovell's scamper and the score held until early in the fourth quarter. On Allen Park's only venture past midfield in the game, the Jaguars scored to knot the game. Jacobs returned the ensuing kickoff to midfield. The Pioneers winning drive was brief. Following a Nash run, Lovell raced 31 yards, Nash picked up 13 more and Nash capped the four-play drive with a one-yard dive.
